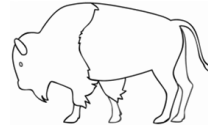


## Four Major Native American Tribal Cultures



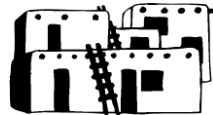
### Northwest

Dwelling: Wooden plank houses  
Clothing: Skirts and raincoats from cedar tree fibers  
Food: Fish, nuts, berries, roots  
Art: Wooden masks & totems, paint, shells  
Transportation: Canoes



### Plains

Dwelling: Buffalo skin tipis  
Clothing: Animal skins and cloth clothing  
Food: Buffalo and other animals, berries, greens, roots  
Art: Feathers, beads, paint  
Transportation: Horses



### All cultures feature the drum



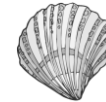
### Southwest

Dwelling: Adobe houses  
Food: Seeds, corn, small animals  
Clothing: Mostly cloth  
Art: Clay pottery, weaving, turquoise and silverwork



### East Coast

Dwelling: Wooden bark long houses  
Clothing: Animal skins and cloth  
Food: Corn, gourds, tomatoes, pumpkins, fish  
Art: Shell and bone beads, copper  
Transportation: Canoes



### Texas

The cultures of the vast majority of American Indians now living in Texas derived from Southeastern U.S. tribes.
